1	Incomplete submission.	Submission has no PDF, or broken PDF.	Webpage, submission form.
2	Bad formatting/template	Wrong template, over length or under length (more than a few lines).	Webpage, submission form.
3	Bad metadata format.	The title, abstract or author names have characters that are not alphanumeric or basic punctuation. Letters can have accents. Graphic characters such as emojis are not allowed. Latex code is not allowed either.	Webpage, submission form. E-mail (to all co-authors) upon registering the paper.
4	Exceeding # submissions / author.	Authors submitting more than n papers will see their n+1, n+2, etc submissions (in submission ID order) desk-rejected. Independently of whether or not one of the first n submissions is desk rejected for another reason. Proposal after seeing MM'25 numbers n=10.	Webpage, submission form. E-mail (to all co-authors) after registration deadline.
5	Responsible review.	One or more of the co-authors did not submit the review on time, or the submitted review is of insufficient quality (at the discretion of the Program Chairs).  This implies a limited number ( $r=4$ ) of reviews per reviewer.	Webpage, submission form. E-mail (to all co-authors) after paper registration deadline. E-mail (to all co-authors) after paper deadline. E-mail (to all co-authors) after assignment deadline. One (to all co-authors) email per week during the review process with the current status. Last e-mail reminder (to all co-authors) three days before the review deadline.
6	Clear prove of AI generated review	There is enough evidence that one of the co-authors, in their review duties, has used AI to generate one of their reviews. The use of AI tools to enhance the language formulation is allowed.	Webpage, submission form.
7	Hidden prompt to condition automatic AI reviews.	The paper has a co-author that co-authored a paper (not necessarily the same paper) containing a hidden prompt to condition automatic AI reviews. <b>To clarify:</b> if a paper has such a hidden prompt, ALL papers of ALL co-authors of this paper will be desk-rejected. <del><b>Alternatively:</b> The paper with the conditional prompt is desk rejected AND ALL the authors are banned from submitting to ACM MM for <math>y(=2)</math> years. (This is far more difficult to implement due to potential different OpenReview profiles/e-mail addresses).</del>	Webpage, submission form. E-mail (to all co-authors) upon registering the paper. E-mail (to all co-authors) after the registration deadline.
8	Out of scope.	Clear out of scope regarding the themes and subjects.	Webpage, submission form.
